# **Chair's Report**

It is with great pride that I present this report to our members.

Throughout the year, your Board has worked closely with a number of Clubs, and I acknowledge with gratitude the contribution made by Tauranga Swimming Club, Te Puke Swimming Club and Opotiki Swimming Club, and look forward to supporting them in their new pathway of delivering swimming to their communities without the restraints of being a registered Club with SBOP and SNZ. # **Technical Officials Report**

It is encouraging that this year there has been a number of people qualifying as referees, with several more that are likely to achieve this qualification in the coming year.

Clubs should continue to encourage people to become officials. Experienced IOTs and starters in particular should consider progressing to become Judge of Strokes/ Referees.

There are experienced technical & senior club officials available and willing to spend time as mentors. Please contact your official's coordinator or a member of the Technical Committee, who can provide you with information that will assist you to gain your qualification. The exams are not difficult and are designed to ensure that all swimmers get a fair go from all officials on pool deck.
