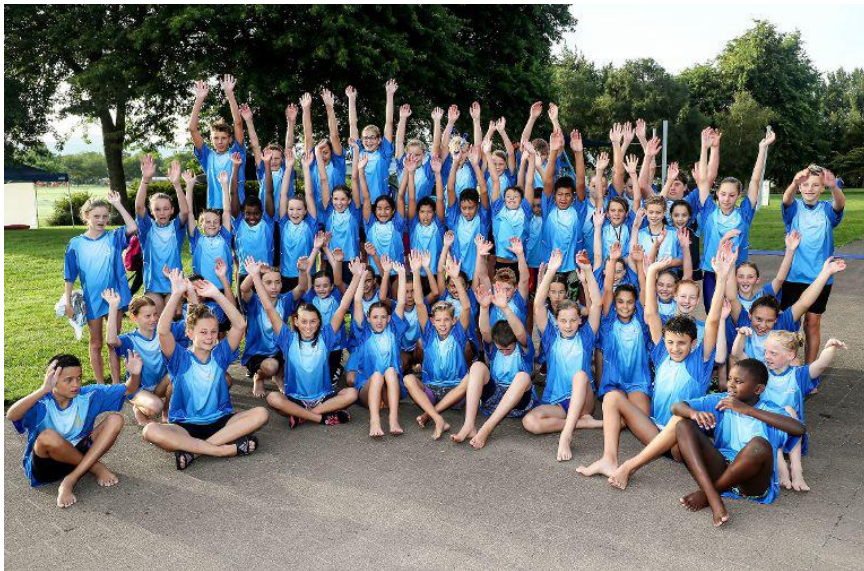

Chair's Report

It is always a pleasure to do a report for the AGM of Swimming Bay of Plenty and I trust you enjoy the different format used this year which is a snapshot of what we have done.

We were thrilled to introduce the Inaugural Junior League.

We believed that for our junior athletes (12 and under) the emphasis should be placed heavily on skill development and the fun of participation. Our calendar in the past had been cluttered with no real progressions from one meet to the next. We wanted to attract young people into swimming so this League provided a more structured pathway from Junior League to Junior Swim Meets to Premier Meets and beyond. To keep our young swimmers in our sport, we needed to be providing an environment that encouraged them, and kept the level of competition and pressure appropriate for their age. Our research had disclosed that our sport carried many large barriers to entry when compared with other sports at a junior level. These barriers included (but were not limited to) high participation cost in both terms of time and money. Therefore at the Junior League all athletes paid one flat fee with a maximum 3 individual events, the League was open to all registered BOP 12 and under athletes both competitive and Club athletes, a time limit of 3 hours was set for the meet and no racing suits were permitted. We were humbled by the participation and feedback and have launched the Junior League for the 2018/2019 season and are introducing a Senior League.



Junior Camp

Our Junior Camp has been running for over a decade (15 plus years) and continues to grow in strength. All athletes that have qualified for the Junior Festival come together with the emphasis on TEAM. They train together, stay together and race together as a SBOP Team at a Club hosted event the following morning.



Hosting the SNZ Junior Aquaknights Festival and SNZ National Division II Competition

We welcomed 100 Clubs and 586 athletes to Rotorua for Division II (March 2018) and 31 Clubs and 355 athletes for the Aquaknights Festival (Feb 2018) within a four week period.

It was a privilege to host these athletes, clubs, parents and supporters. We have an exceptional relationship within our community and this was integral to ensure we were able to deliver a great environment and a fun experience for all. We are looking forward to hosting the 2019 Junior Aquaknights Junior Festival.



Assessment “Health” Check

Health Check 1 - Grow participation: It was pleasing to see a slight increase in our Competitive athlete numbers.

Health Check 2 -Achieve Excellence: Increase in overall representation at National Events. Record numbers selected for Swimming New Zealand Teams and athletes continue to break NZ Records from within our Region.

Health Check 3 -Strong Governance: Robust processes in place for formation of new Club’s. Swimming Bay of Plenty officials presented with a SBOP branded Polo shirt. All athletes at Junior Festival, Division II, National Age Groups and Opens presented with a Swimming Bay of Plenty branded T-Shirt. All athletes in attendance at Awards Brunch presented with a branded SBOP drink bottle.

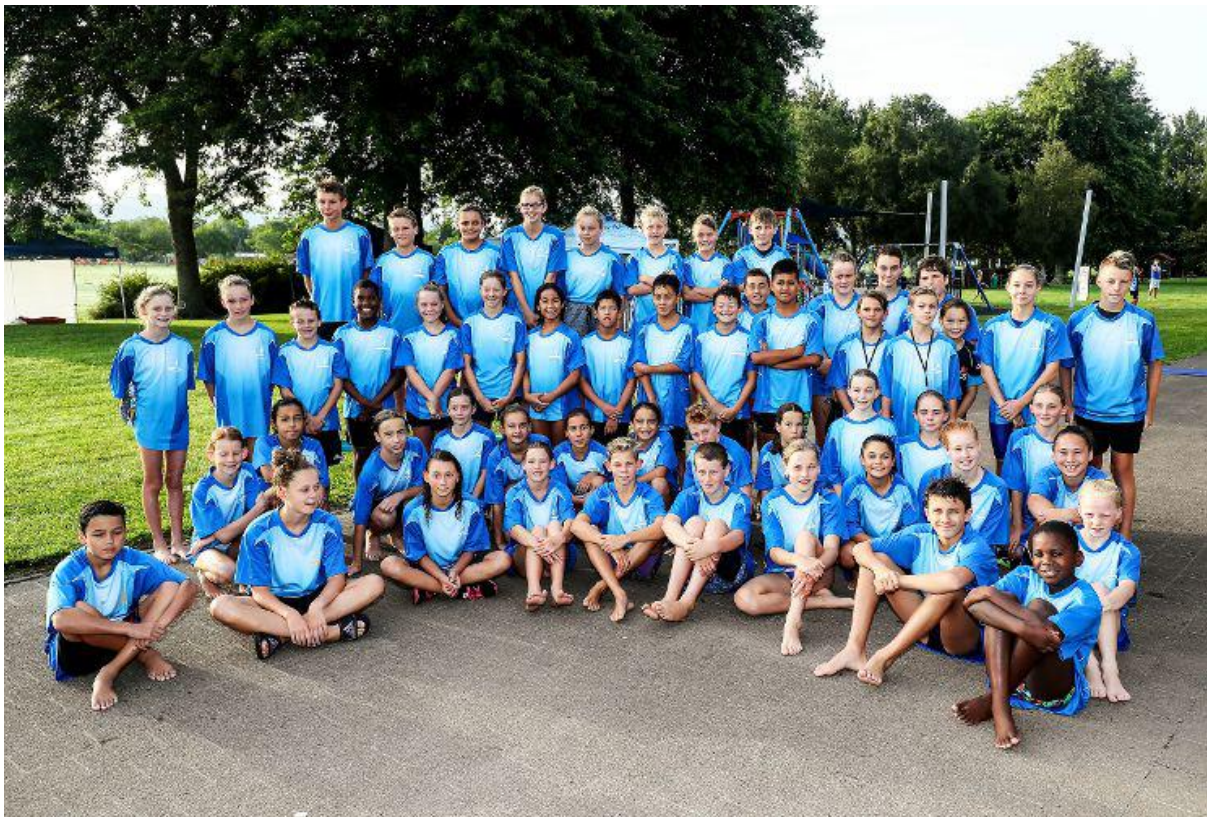
