



Swimming Bay of Plenty AOD Operator Assessment

Pre Requisites for Qualification:

Timekeeper exam

Registered in the Stratum Database as a non voting technical official (minimum)

To become a qualified AOD operator the member must be able to demonstrate the following:

- AOD operator can unpack and assemble the AOD equipment without assistance.
- AOD operator can carry out pre-meet function tests correctly to ensure AOD is ready for service.
- AOD operator can operate AOD equipment to time the swim meet without assistance.
- AOD operator can identify and rectify equipment defects that affect the timing system without assistance. Eg faulty pad or backup button
- AOD operator can dismantle and correctly stow the AOD equipment to ensure it is not damaged during transport.
- A trainee operator must sit along side a qualified AOD operator for a minimum of five meets. The assessment will be carried out by a BOP appointed assessor, and the Assessment form from the Colorado Timing System Operator Training and Assessment Manual (Appendix A) completed and sent to Swimming BOP.
