## **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT**

It has been another strong year for Swimming Bay of Plenty with our membership stable, our finances strong, and some excellent results in the water from our athletes. I want to acknowledge our Board members for their contribution, and our Clubs for their ongoing support of swimming in our region.

We have had a number of successful achievements from both experienced and new swimmers. Congratulations to Kane Radford on qualifying for the Rio Olympics, Congratulations to Bianca Donelley, Jack Weston and Paddy Baylis for being selected for Swimming New Zealand Teams, Congratulations to all those swimmers who were selected for National Development Programmes and Aquaknights Team selection. Congratulations to all athletes that are rewriting the record books both at a Regional and New Zealand level. More importantly, congratulations to all our swimmers who competed with excellent sportsmanship. Their good behaviour and positive attitude is a credit not only to themselves but to their clubs and swimming programme.

My sincere thanks to all those parents who have gained official qualifications.

There are, however, signs of cross-winds in our sport both at a national level and a regional level and this will require some strong and proactive steps to be taken to build the sport in our region. The level of ongoing funding at a national level remains uncertain while the powers that be digest the results of our Olympic Team in Rio, a number of our Clubs are seeing their membership levels drop (and particularly of those involved in competitive swimming), and there are some signs that Clubs are finding it more difficult to attract people to be involved in governance and to attract and retain excellent coaches. As competitive membership levels drop, Clubs are also finding it increasingly difficult to retain older swimmers who need the social interaction that numbers provide.

As a Board, we believe that the key to the success of our sport in the region is larger and stronger, well-run Clubs with great coaches. However, we also believe that the success of our sport depends on supporting swimming more effectively at a grassroots level. Our focus for the next 12 months will be working with Clubs to try and achieve both of these things. We are exploring with Clubs different ways of collaborating, partnering and even merging together so our athletes are given the best possible experience – both in terms of access to excellent coaching but also in terms of giving them the benefit of training with a wider group of athletes (something that is important for the development of their swimming and also the social stimulation it provides). We are committed to supporting Clubs to finding new ways of working, but we will also be looking much more closely at whether existing Clubs are meeting the minimum requirements of a registered Club in terms of swimmer numbers, sustainability and governance.

Other things we are looking forward to in the coming year include working with Coaches and Clubs to develop a swimming calendar that encourages excellence from our competitive swimmers, and that encourages participation from our younger swimmers. We intend doing more to establish regional pathways and development opportunities, and to recognise and support outstanding coaching.

We are extremely positive about what the future holds, but know that there need to be changes to the way the sport is governed. Our focus at all times must remain on our swimmers and creating the best possible experience for them and if this requires changes to the way we all work we should be prepared to do this. We are certainly up for the challenge and looking forward to working with our Clubs to lift our sport in the region.

## **TECHNICAL OFFICIALS REPORT**

My congratulations to all those officials, who have gained their SBOP (111 assessments completed) or NZ qualifications (6 assessments completed) this year. It has been an ongoing focus of the technical committee to encourage our existing team of officials to improve their skills and qualifications at both Bay of Plenty and New Zealand levels. It is encouraging that this year there have been a number of people qualifying as BOP referees with several are likely to achieve this qualification in the coming year. The result of this is we have good numbers of qualified officials from Referees to Time keepers.

It is still important for clubs to encourage their members to become Technical officials. There are experienced senior officials in most clubs who are available and willing to spend time as mentors, with members of the technical committee available to help with training material / training requirements or exams. The exams are not difficult and are designed to ensure that all swimmers get a fair go from the officials.

Thank you to all officials, both local and from other Regions who have assisted at our swim meets Over the past 12 months. We hope that your involvement was enjoyable and rewarding, and look forward to seeing you on pool deck in the future.
