

## Minutes of the SGM held 27 July 2014

Taupo SC moved that Swimming BOP adopt the new constitution. Whakatane seconded.

Wayne Johnstone spoke against the move. He has taken legal advice and believes we do not have to accept the new constitution as prescribed by SNZ. He urged clubs to vote against the motion.

Henry spoke about the last twelve months and how the constitution is an attempt to drive a coherent and same approach to swimming, the whole of sport plan is to integrate the sport of swimming. We have been advised that SNZ will make some changes around the numbers clubs need to have. All existing clubs will remain members and not have to meet all criteria. New clubs however will have to meet new criteria

Steve Delaney spoke against the motion saying the SNZ constitution should be amended to reflect minimum club criteria before we adopt ours.

Wayne pointed out we cannot amend without SNZ approval. BOP will lose our identity and our logo. Why change what is not broken.

We can have people appointed who are not members of SBOP- should this be allowed?  
Life members do not have a vote.

All SNZ want is control of our members' money and people.

Henry referred to the review- cohesion across regions with SNZ nation system for swimming that makes sense. We either join and make a go of it or go against and stand out.

Difference between constitutions is not material. Regions can establish own strategic position.

There have been many successes for our Region but success does not come without hard work. There are many hard workers in our organisation who we do not necessarily acknowledge as often as we should and there are far too many to mention by name. Our Clubs are actually our members and the people behind our clubs are really what keep’s our organisation afloat. Without our Club committees we would not survive and we probably do not acknowledge the people behind our clubs. Following the updates of the Swimming Bay of Plenty Constitution at last year’s AGM the Board reviewed the vision of Swimming Bay of Plenty. The 2015-2017 Strategic Plan was communicated via our website. I would also like to reiterate that Clubs work through the Swimming Bay Plenty Club Self-assessment document that was communicated to all Clubs. Clubs rely heavily on the support from volunteers, therefore effective management structures, documentation systems and operational processes are imperative. This is critical now that we are operating under new constitutions.

Thank you also to our officials, who give up their time at Meets to be on pool deck and keep our meets running efficiently. We are lucky to have such a great group of officials who work so well together and enjoy what they are doing.

Our successes in 2014/2015 were many –

We have had a significant increase in membership, and increasing competitive success.

We were thrilled to have both Kane Radford and Nathan Capp qualify for the 2015 World Championships and Kane win a 10km Bronze medal in the 10km Open Water Event at Pan Pac’s.

We had a record number of athletes selected for the SNZ High Performance Development Programme Camps (Junior and Age Group)

Our Short Course and Junior Championships were a success.

Our Awards Brunch was held with record numbers. Trophies were presented to a number of athletes and we thank those members who attended.

The Relay Championships was attended with record numbers and is always the most fun. Some fast and furious racing but great fun was had by all.

There were many Club meets during the year and congratulations to all who helped in the organisation of these meets and those hosted by Swimming Bay of Plenty. There is much work involved in organising meets and very often goes unnoticed by those around. We come, we swim, and we go home and forget that someone has worked very hard to enable us to attend – so THANKYOU to everyone who is involved.

Swimming Bay of Plenty has update their website through SNZ [www.bayofplenty.swimming.org.nz](http://www.bayofplenty.swimming.org.nz) We will continue to use emails as the primary form of communication but we would like to promote the use of our website and facebook to help roll out instant news updates and we encourage all members to visit it regularly.

Another success during the year was the Coaches forum regarding the SBOP Calendar and subsequent Delegates meeting ratifying this new format. We know that implementing a calendar pathway in a diverse and widespread geographical region will continue to be a challenge, but we're confident that the passion and capability of the people involved will ensure that we continue to make steps in the right direction. We are fortunate to have a high quality of coaching – in particular we congratulate Alastair Johnson (Swim Rotorua) on achieving Gold Accreditation, we welcome Mike Lee (Otumoetai) back to his roots and John Pike who has recently taken up a coaching position at the Mount Maunganui Swim Club.

We have continued to maintain a strong financial position. Our goal is to ensure we have adequate funds to ensure we can provide support for our swimmers of all ages and standards through 2015/16 and beyond.

It is heartening to read in the annual reports of our Clubs that some are experiencing something of rejuvenation and we wish those even better times ahead.

It is encouraging to see club members working towards both coaching and official accreditation.

Our commitment to the Central Swimming project continues to offer a number of pathways for our athletes and coaches.

After all is said and done, I am very, very proud of our swimmers, coaches, parents, and volunteers-- and their tremendous effort in our sport. I thank you with all my heart and wish you all the best and I look forward to building on the past season on multiple levels. We have exciting new ventures to implement.




